Step 1 - The Eco-Schools Committee



The following is a general description of the committee:	Ahli Jawatankuasa Eco-Schools Malaysia SJK (T) Ladang Semenyih telah dipilih berdasarkan minat semua ahli yang mempunyai minat yang mendalam dalam pendidikan alam sekitar. Ahli jawatankuasa terdiri daripada warga sekolah (guru dan pelajar) serta melibatkan Wakil PIBG, Wakil Kerajaan (Universiti Putra Malaysia) dan Wakil Bukan Kerajaan (NGO) iaitu Persatuan Transformasi Masyarakat Dan Industri Melalui Pendidikan Dan Penyelidikan. AJK Eco-School melibatkan pelajar adalah berdasarkan kelas bagi menjalankan kajian alam sekitar di kawasan sekolah. Guru Penasihat pula dipilih berikutan minat cikgu berkenaan di dalam aktiviti berkaitan kesedaran penjagaan pendidikan alam sekitar. Jawatankuasa ini terbentuk selepas Program Perintis SJKT Hijau Di Daerah Hulu Langat melibatkan semua Warga sekolah bersama wakil kerajaan (ahli akademik dari UPM) dan ahli NGO (Persatuan Transformasi Masyarakat Dan Industri Melalui Pendidikan Dan Penyelidikan). Selepas program tersebut semua ahli sebulat suara bersetuju untuk terlibat secara langsung dalam Program Eco-Schools Malaysia. 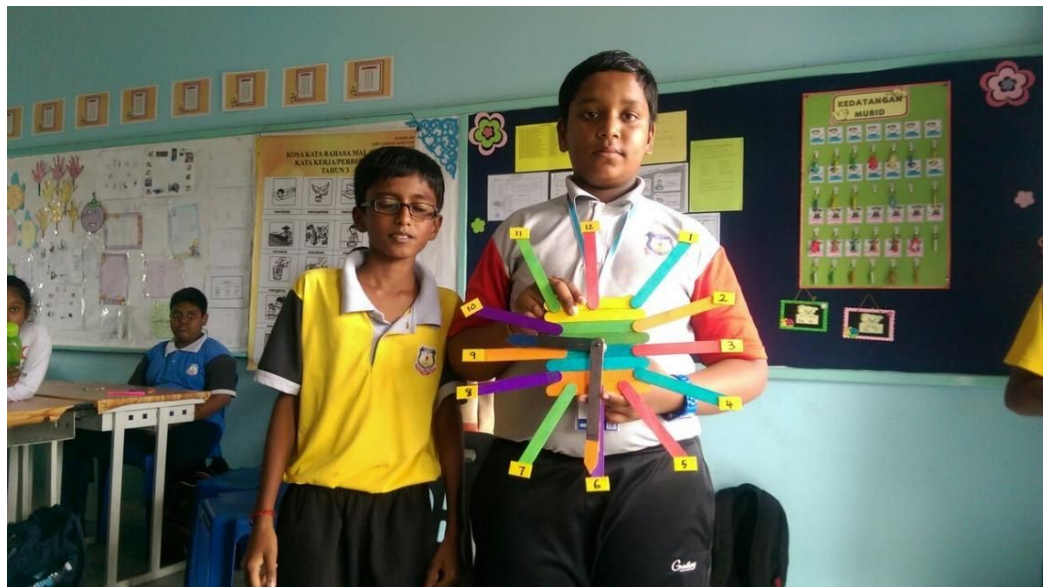

The following are examples of how monitoring is carried out to assess the progress of specific activities:

Bagi mencapai objektif yang disasarkan dalam program ini, Jawatankuasa EcoSchools SJKT Semenyih telah pun menjalankan pemantauan berkala bagi memastikan rancangan dan target yang disasarkan berjaya mencapai sasaran yang ditetapkan.

En.R.Vijayandran selaku Guru Penyelaras Eco-School SJKT Semenyih telah dipilih untuk mengetuai badan pemantau yang dianggotai beberapa kumpulan murid yang diberi tugas-tugasan berdasarkan tema yang telah dipilih.

Pelajar yang terlibat di dalam pemantauan telah dilatih dan diberikan tunjuk ajar oleh beliau untuk menjalankan pemantauan yang lebih berkesan. Peringkat kedua yang dijalankan ialah penilaian program. Aspek penilaian amat penting bagi melihat hasil keberkesanan pemantauan dan perkembangan aktiviti yang dijalankan.

Keputusan penilaian adalah seperti berikut iaitu jumlah penyertaan pelajar dalam program kitar semula amat membanggakan. Di samping itu, amaun barangan kitar semula yang dikumpul juga semakin bertambah memandangkan penyertaan pelajar di dalam program ini semakin bertambah.

The following are examples of how pupils' involvement in Eco-Schools has led to a rise in educational achievement:	Melalui program Eco-Schools, peningkatan dalam aktiviti pendidikan dan peningkatan markah dalam peperiksaan bagi pelajar yang menyertai Eco –Schools adalah antara impak yang boleh dikenalpasti. Selain daripada itu, program ini juga telah meningkatkan semangat kerjasama di kalangan para guru dalam menerapkan nilai murni dan pendidikan alam sekitar di dalam proses pengajaran dan pembelajaran mereka. Misalnya bagi mata pelajaran Pendidikan Moral, murid-murid telah diajar membuat mengenai kertas kitar semula. Dalam mata pelajaran Sains, pelajar diajar mengenai kepentingan kitar semula kepada masyarakat dan alam sekitar. Dalam mata pelajaran Bahasa Tamil, pelajar dapat mempraktikkan aspek mencintai alam sekitar melalui pelbagai cara seperti teka teki, peta minda, karangan dan berpantun . Melalui kaedah ini ia juga akan melatih pelajar agar sedar bahawa banyak barangan yang digunakan seharian dapat dikitar semula untuk kegunaan mereka. Dengan itu didapati proses pembelajaran menjadi lebih menarik dan meningkatkan minat pelajar untuk belajar mata pelajaran berkenaan.
