The FEE EcoCampus Committee

- ☐ Student volunteers from all campus entities (faculties, institutes, centres etc) are to be part of the FEE Committee, facilitated by an academic staff.
- ☐ The Committee meets at least once every half-semester.
- ☐ Minutes of the meetings / all written records are kept under the joint responsibility of students and academic staff.
- ☐ Students are given the opportunity to nominate wider campus community to be represented on the FEE EcoCampus Committee for special tasks.

Environmental Review

- ☐ The Committee and selected members of the wider campus community plan and carry out an environmental audit of the campus for a certain theme or themes.
- ☐ The results of the audit are discussed and analysed by the Committee together with selected members of the wider campus community.
- ☐ The whole campus is informed about the results of the audit explicitly within the campus.

Action Plan

- ❑ The Committee draws up an action plan prioritising specific targets based on the audit.
- ❑ The Committee together with the selected members from the wider campus community agree to take responsibility for implementing the action plan within a specified timeframe for completion.

Monitoring & Evaluation

- ❑ The Committee together with selected members of the wider campus committee review progress against set specific targets.
- ❑ The Committee reports progress of the action plan to the whole campus by appropriate means on a regular basis.
- ❑ Feedback from the whole campus (students academic and non-academic staff and the general campus workers) is elicited through informal interviews.
- ❑ The Committee analyses and highlights strengths and weaknesses of the action plan.

Curriculum Work

- ❑ Some aspects of the FEE EcoCampus activities are purposively integrated into several selected course curricula in each entity on campus (faculties, institutes, centres etc.).

Informing & Involving

- ❑ An FEE EcoCampus notice board is kept in a prominent position within the campus to inform the whole campus community about activities and status of each activity.
- ❑ Volunteers from the wider campus community are engaged in the FEE EcoCampus activities (and not just committee members).
- ❑ FEE EcoCampus activities are reported in the Centre for Academic Development (eg. Pusat Perkembangan Akademik -PPA) Bulletin.



Green Charter

- ❑ The Committee suggests the Green Charter to the wider campus community (all entities) for their agreement.
